Scope of Practice

Temporary Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor

The Temporary Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (TCADC) – The Scope of Practice for the category of those with a bachelor's degree/master's includes the following activities under the supervision of a board-certified supervisor (LCADC, LADC or CADC):

- 1. Clinical evaluation, including diagnostic impression or impression and/or screening, assessment, and diagnosis of substance use disorders.
- 2. Treatment planning for SUDs, including initial, ongoing, continuity of care, discharge, and planning for relapse prevention.
- 3. Referral
- 4. Service coordination and case management for SUDs
- $5. \ Counseling, the rapy, trauma informed care, and psycho-education with individuals, families, and groups \\$
- 6. Client, family, and community education
- 7. Documentation
- 8. Professional and ethical responsibilities
