**This workshop satisfies 201 KAR 35:070 Supervision Experience for Board-approved Supervisors:**

**Section 4. (1) A Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor or Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor who has been approved by the board as a supervisor shall attend a board approved training session in supervisory practices within twelve (12) months of obtaining approval as a supervisor.**

**Note:** The Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors will be holding Board-approved training sessions in supervisory practices approximately 2-3 times a year at no cost to attendees. Board-approved supervisors **must** attend one of these Board-approved sessions within 12 months of obtaining approval as a supervisor to meet this requirement under 201 KAR 35:070 – other supervisory training certificates will not be accepted. If you are planning to become a Board-approved supervisor in the future, you may attend this training before receiving approval. The “Request to Provide Supervision” application found at [adc.ky.gov](http://adc.ky.gov) must also be submitted to the Board for approval to become a Board-approved supervisor (CADCs must have 2+ years’ experience and LCADCs may apply at any time). Future training sessions will be posted on the Board’s website as soon as dates and locations are confirmed. Please check the Board’s website regularly for upcoming trainings.

***If you already attended one of these sessions within 12 months of receiving your approval as a Board-approved supervisor, you have already met this requirement and do not need to attend again.***
