3.0 CEUs are approved by the KY Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors

This workshop satisfies 201 KAR 35:070 Supervision Experience for Board-approved Supervisors:
Section 4. (1)(a) A Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor, Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor, or Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor requesting to become approved by the board as a supervisor shall:

- 1. Submit a complete and signed Form 4 Request to Provide Supervision;**
- 2. For a CADC or LADC, have at least two (2) years of post-certification experience AND have attended the board-sponsored supervision training;**
- 3. For a LCADC, have at least twelve (12) months of post-licensure experience OR have attended the board-sponsored supervision training;**
- 4. Submit information as to whether or not the applicant has any unresolved complaints.**

(2) A board approved supervisor shall obtain a minimum of three (3) board-sponsored continuing education hours in supervision theory or techniques in each three(3) year renewal cycle.

Note: The Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors will be holding Board-approved training sessions in supervisory practices approximately 2-3 times a year at no cost to attendees. Board-approved supervisors **must** attend one of these Board-approved sessions to meet the requirements under 201 KAR 35:070 – other supervisory training certificates will not be accepted. If you are planning to become a Board-approved supervisor in the future, you may attend this training before receiving approval. The “Request to Provide Supervision” application found at adc.ky.gov must also be submitted to the Board for approval to become a Board-approved supervisor. Future training sessions will be posted on the Board’s website as soon as dates and locations are confirmed. Please check the Board’s website regularly for upcoming trainings.
