FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors (hereinafter as "Board") regarding a disciplinary complaint against Respondent Craig A. MacInnes (hereinafter as "Respondent"). The Board has reviewed the record and finds that a Board Recommended Order of Revocation of License 0925-119859 was issued on August 4, 2017 and no appeal of that recommended order has been filed with the agency head. Therefore, the Board hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

(1) The Board's Recommended Order of Revocation of License 0925-119859 issued on August 4, 2017 is hereby **ADOPTED**;

(2) The notice of revocation and notice of the right to appeal the decision within twenty (20) days was delivered to the Respondent and his counsel, by certified mail, and received on September 21, 2017;

(3) On December 6, 2017, the Board Administrator reviewed the record and notified the Board that no response was received from the Respondent or counsel; and

(4) The Board hereby finds that the time for appeal of the Recommended Order has expired and **ISSUES THIS FINAL ORDER** revoking license 0925-119859;


(5) The Respondent may apply for reinstatement of license 0925-119859 on or after

December 4, 2018 by submitting an Application for Reinstatement with the Board pursuant to KRS 309.087; AND

(6) Respondent may appeal this Final Order by filing an original action in Franklin Circuit Court within thirty (30) days of receipt of service or delivery of this order, pursuant to KRS 13B.140(1).

WHEREFORE, the Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors issues this final order regarding license 0925-119859.
