FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors (hereinafter as "Board") regarding a disciplinary complaint against Respondent Heather Pauline (hereinafter as "Respondent"). The Board has reviewed the record and finds that a Board Disciplinary Notice was issued on August 31, 2017 and no appeal has been filed with the Board. Pursuant to 201 KAR 35:060, Section 4(4)(c), the Disciplinary Notice became effective upon the expiration of time for Respondent to appeal, September 19, 2017. Therefore, the Board hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

(1) The Board's Disciplinary Notice in the matter of License No. 1038-120011, issued on August 31, 2017, is hereby **ADOPTED**;

(2) The Disciplinary Notice and notice of the right to appeal was sent to Respondent's mailing address as provided by Respondent to the Board,

(3) No response to the Disciplinary Notice has been received by the Board since its issuance; and

(4) The Board hereby finds that the time for appeal has expired and **ISSUES THIS FINAL ORDER**:

a. Respondent's license shall be **SUSPENDED** for a period of two (2) years. The

first six (6) months of this suspension shall be served. The period of suspension is from September 19, 2017 to February 19, 2018. The remaining eighteen (18) months' suspension is **PROBATED** on the condition that Respondent satisfactorily completes the terms of probation as set forth below:

- i. During the period of probation, Respondent shall be supervised by a board-approved supervisor and meet for face-to-face individual supervision for one (1) hour every two (2) weeks, at her own expense, throughout the period of probation in accordance with 201 KAR 35:070, Section 13. Respondent shall submit three (3) names of board-approved supervisors with whom Respondent does not have a dual relationship within twenty (20) days of the date of this Final Order.
- ii. The approved supervisor shall submit monthly reports to the Board along with the supervision logs maintained by the supervisor.
- iii. Respondent shall complete twelve (12) hours of continuing education on ethics, which shall not be applied to the continuing education requirement for renewal under 201 KAR 35:040, no later than 180 days from the date of this Final Order; and
- iv. Respondent shall not violate any provisions of KRS 309.080 to 309.089 or 201 KAR Chapter 35.

(5) Respondent may appeal this Final Order by filing an original action in Franklin Circuit Court or in the Circuit Court where Respondent resides within thirty (30) days of receipt of service or delivery of this order, pursuant to KRS 13B.140(1) and KRS 309.086.

WHEREFORE, the Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors issues this final order regarding license 1038 – 120011.
