7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 309.0813(1)

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 309.0813 requires the Kentucky  
9 Board of Alcohol and Drug Counselors to promulgate administrative regulations **for the**  
10 **administration and enforcement of KRS 309.080 to 309.089 and** establishing requirements for  
11 alcohol and drug counselors, **certified clinical supervisors**, and peer support specialists. This  
12 administrative regulation establishes definitions of terms used by the board in administrative  
13 regulations pertaining to the **administration and enforcement of KRS 309.080 to 309.089,**  
14 **credentialing of alcohol and drug counselors, certified clinical supervisors,** and peer support  
15 specialists.

16 Section 1. (1) "Academic course" means a course that is offered by a postsecondary  
17 institution accredited by a recognized accreditation agency and that is:

18 (a) An alcohol and drug counseling course, designated by title or content; or

19 (b) An academic course, relevant to alcohol and drug counseling.

1 (2) "Applicant" means an individual who has applied for temporary registration,  
2 registration, temporary certification, certification, or licensure in accordance with KRS 309.084 or  
3 a credential holder renewing a~~his~~ credential~~[application]~~ in accordance with KRS 309.085.

4 (3) "Approved" means recognized by the Kentucky Board of Alcohol and Drug  
5 Counselors.

6 (4) "Board" is defined by KRS 309.080(1).

7 (5) "Certified alcohol and drug counselor associate I" is defined by KRS 309.080(2).

8 (6) "Certified alcohol and drug counselor associate II" is defined by KRS 309.080(3).

9 (7) "Certified alcohol and drug counselor" is defined by KRS 309.080(4).

10 **(8) "Certified clinical supervisor" is defined by KRS 309.080(5).**

11 ~~(9)~~~~(8)~~ "Chair" means the chairperson or vice-chairperson of the board.

12 ~~(10)~~~~(9)~~~~(7)~~ "Charge" means a specific allegation contained in a formal complaint, as  
13 established in subsection ~~(15)~~~~(14)~~~~(12)~~ of this section, issued by the board alleging a violation  
14 of a specified provision of KRS Chapter 309, the administrative regulations promulgated  
15 thereunder, or another state or federal statute or regulation.

16 ~~(11)~~~~(10)~~~~(8)~~ "Classroom hour" means an academic hour from an accredited institution  
17 or continuing education hour.

18 ~~(12)~~~~(11)~~~~(9)~~ "Client" means an individual, family, or group who directly receives  
19 services from an alcohol and drug counselor or peer support specialist; a corporate entity or other  
20 organization if the contract is to provide an alcohol and drug counselor or peer support specialist  
21 service of benefit directly to the corporate entity or organization; or a legal guardian who is  
22 responsible for making decisions relative to the provision of services for a minor or legally  
23 incompetent adult.

2 principles are transformed into practical skills, with four (4) overlapping foci: administrative,  
3 evaluative, clinical, and supportive.

4            ~~(14)~~~~(13)~~~~(11)~~ “Clinical supervisor” means a certified alcohol and drug counselor who  
5 has at least two (2) years of ~~post-certification~~~~post-credential~~ experience and has attended the  
6 board-sponsored supervision training who provides supervision and whose credential is currently  
7 in good standing with the board, or a licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselor who has at least  
8 twelve (12) months of post-licensure experience or has attended the board-sponsored supervision  
9 training who provides supervision and whose credential is currently in good standing with the  
10 board.

12 individual or another person, alleging a violation of:

- 13            (a) KRS Chapter 309;

- 16            (d) A combination of paragraphs (a), (b), or (c) of this subsection.

7            (b) Publicly reprimand, publicly admonish, or fine.

10            (a) Planned and evaluated to meet behavioral objectives; and

13 the disciplinary process with the intent of reaching a resolution~~[dispensation]~~ of a matter without

## REGULATORY IMPACT ANALYSIS AND TIERING STATEMENT

(1) Provide a brief summary of:

(a) What this administrative regulation does: This administrative regulation defines the terms used in 201 KAR Chapter 35.

(b) The necessity of this administrative regulation: This regulation is necessary to define the terms used in 201 KAR Chapter 35.

(c) How this administrative regulation conforms to the content of the authorizing statutes: The authorizing statute, KRS 309.0813(1) requires the board to promulgate regulations pursuant to KRS Chapter 13A for the administration and enforcement of KRS 309.080 to 309.089. KRS 309.0813(2), (4), (5), and (12) further require the board to establish requirements regarding standards of practice, continuing education, examinations, the process to obtain a credential, and to establish certain fees.

(d) How this administrative regulation currently assists or will assist in the effective administration of the statutes: This regulation will provide a definition for terms used in 201 KAR Chapter 35.

(2) If this is an amendment to an existing administrative regulation, provide a brief summary of:

(a) How the amendment will change this existing administrative regulation: The amendment will change the existing administrative regulation by: (1) adding temporary registration and temporary certification to the definition of “applicant”; (2) making pronouns gender neutral; (3) clarifying that a credential holder renews a credential not an application; (4) adding definitions for certified alcohol and drug counselor associate I and II; (5) updating statutory location for certified alcohol and drug counselor; (6) changing definition for “clinical supervisor” to reflect changes in statutory requirements, specifically, defining a clinical supervisor as a certified alcohol and drug counselor who has two (2) years of post-certification experience and has attended the board-sponsored training or a licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselor who has at least twelve (12) months of post-licensure experience or has attended the board-sponsored supervision training; (7) deleting reference to the executive director of the Division of Occupations and Professions as a non-voting member of the complaint screening committee; (8) updating definition of credential holder to mean a person who has a credential issued by the board pursuant to KRS 309.080 to 309.089; (9) removing the Attorney General” from the definition of “investigator.” The Amended After Comments version will also change this existing administrative regulation by adding definitions for “Certified clinical supervisor” and “Licensed alcohol and drug counselor”.

(b) The necessity of the amendment to this administrative regulation: This amendment is necessary to have clear definitions for terms used in the board’s regulations. Further, the Amended After Comments version will also add references to the “certified clinical supervisor” and “licensed alcohol and drug counselor” credentials created by KRS 309.0830 and .0834 (2021 Ky. Acts ch. 107, Senate Bill 166).

(c) How the amendment conforms to the content of the authorizing statutes: The amendment conforms to the content of the authorizing statute. The authorizing statute, KRS 209.0813(1), requires the board to promulgate regulations pursuant to KRS Chapter 13A for the administration and enforcement of KRS 309.080 to 309.089. KRS 309.0813(2), (4), (5), and (12) further require the board to establish requirements regarding standards of practice, continuing education, examinations, the process to obtain a credential, and to establish certain fees.

(d) How the amendment will assist in the effective administration of the statutes: The amendment will assist in the effective administration of the statutes by providing clear definitions for terms used in the board’s regulations.

(3) List the type and number of individuals, businesses, organizations, or state and local governments affected by this administrative regulation: The board is unable to determine the exact number of persons who would be impacted by this regulation since the applications vary from month to month. Future applicants and persons credentialed by the board will be affected by this administrative regulation. As of February 1, 2021 there were 513 licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselors, 21 licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselor associates, 458 certified alcohol and drug counselors, 930 temporary certified alcohol and drug counselors, 95 temporary registered alcohol and drug peer support specialists, and 15 registered alcohol and drug peer support specialists.

(4) Provide an analysis of how the entities identified in the previous question will be impacted by either the implementation of this administrative regulation, if new, or by the change, if it is an amendment, including:

(a) List the actions each of the regulated entities have to take to comply with this regulation or amendment: There are no actions needed to be taken for compliance of this administrative regulation.

(b) In complying with this administrative regulation or amendment, how much will it cost each of the entities: There is no cost associated with this administrative regulation.

(c) As a result of compliance, what benefits will accrue to the entities: Applicants and credential holders benefit by having the definitions of terms used within the regulations to clarify the regulations and put the licensee on clear notice.

(5) Provide an estimate of how much it will cost the administrative body to implement this administrative regulation:

(a) Initially: Initially, there is no additional cost to the administrative body to implement this

administrative regulation.

(b) On a continuing basis: On a continuing basis, there is no additional cost to the administrative body to implement this administrative regulation.

(6) What is the source of the funding to be used for the implementation and enforcement of this administrative regulation: The board's operations are funded by fees paid by credential holders and applicants.

(7) Provide an assessment of whether an increase in fees or funding will be necessary to implement this administrative regulation, if new, or by the change if it is an amendment: No increase in fees or funding will be required to implement the changes made by this regulation.

(8) State whether or not this administrative regulation established any fees or directly or indirectly increased any fees: This administrative regulation does not establish fees or directly or indirectly increase any fees.

IV. Summary of Comments and Responses

(1) Subject Matter: Senate Bill 166 (2021).

(a) Comment: The passage of SB 166 in the 2021 Legislative Session, effective March 1, 2021, may require changes to the administrative regulations.

(b) Response: The Board agrees. SB 166 created two new credentials, “certified clinical supervisor” and “licensed alcohol and drug counselor”, effective retroactively to March 1, 2021. The changes are in the After Amended Comments (AAC) versions filed with this Statement of Consideration. The changes add definitions for the new credentials (201 KAR 35:010), and add references to the new credentials where applicable regarding fees (201 KAR 35:020), prohibition of use of titles for canceled credentials (201 KAR 35:020), examinations (201 KAR 35:025), continuing education (201 KAR 35:040), curriculum of study (201 KAR 35:050), supervision (201 KAR 35:070), substitution for work experience (201 KAR 35:075), voluntary inactive and retired status (201 KAR 35:080), and to certain related material incorporated by reference (KBADC Form 1 Application (201 KAR 35:020), KBADC Form 10 Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor and Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor Verification of Classroom Training(201 KAR 35:050), KBADC Form 4 Request to Provide Supervision (201 KAR 35:070), and KBADC Form 12 Workplace Experience Substitution Request (201 KAR 35:075)). Further, the AAC creates the KBADC Form 23 Application for Certified Clinical Supervisor as material incorporated by reference (201 KAR 35:020).

(2) Subject Matter: Distinguishing degreed certified alcohol and drug counselors.

(a) Comment: Distinguish individuals who are degreed Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselors.

(b) Response: The Board appreciates the comment, and has determined that this change is not necessary. Accordingly, no amendments will be made to the administrative regulations in response to this comment.

(3) Subject Matter: Clarification.

(a) Comment: Clarify the number of hours for curriculum of study for an applicant seeking registration as an alcohol and drug peer support specialist.

(b) Response: The Board agrees, and a corresponding clarification is in the AAC version of 201 KAR 35:050.

(4) Subject Matter: Continuing Education.

(a) Comment: The comment recommends a clarifying amendment to change “and” to “or in Section 1(1)(b) of 201 KAR 35:040, so that the paragraph reads “A minimum of thirty (30) continuing education hours, including at least six (6) continuing education hours in ethics, each year shall be accrued by each person holding a certificate as a

certified alcohol and drug counselor associate **or** a certified alcohol and drug counselor associate II.” (Emphasis added.)

(b) Response: The Board agrees and will amend 201 KAR 35:040 accordingly.

(5) Subject Matter: Resources that give providers more resources to treat patients.

(a) Comment: The comment states that there is an extreme shortage of certified and licensed professionals available to provide services under the current 908 KAR 370, 372 and 374, and therefore supports the changes that give providers more resources to treat the thousands of patients suffering from SUD and OUD in Kentucky. The comment also expresses a concern that providers of addiction services will have their hands tied until similar changes are made to the listed 908 KAR regulations, 908 KAR 15:022 regulations guiding billable services, and credentials under the Department of Medicaid Services.

(b) Response: The Board appreciates the comment. The comment does not request any changes to the Board’s regulations in 201 KAR Chapter 35. Accordingly, no amendments will be made to the administrative regulations in response to this comment.
